CFWC ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- CFWC endorsed the first Child Labor Law enacted in California.
- CFWC clubs helped to establish the majority of public libraries in California communities
- CFWC initiated a campaign leading to designated traffic direction lanes – that white line down the center of roadways has saved countless lives.
- CFWC assisted with funding and installation of California's mission bells along the El Camino Real.
- CFWC proposed a state bill to establish California's Juvenile Court. Clubs paid the salaries of probation officers until funds could be budgeted by the State.
- CFWC clubs have donated books and educational material worth more than \$1.3 million to public and school libraries.
- CFWC helped create window stickers for use by fire depts. to identify disabled persons living in homes...and, the list goes on!
