Each year, California clubs and club members:

- ♥ Participate in more than 14,000+ philanthropic projects

- ♥ Donate more than \$8 million to 501 (c) 3 nonprofit organizations.
- ♥ Participate in leadership training and programs at all levels of Federation.
- ♥ Participate in enrichment and social activities for personal growth.

CFWC ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ♥ CFWC endorsed the first Child Labor Law enacted in California.
- ♥ CFWC clubs helped to establish the majority of public libraries in California communities
- ♥ CFWC initiated a campaign leading to designated traffic direction lanes – that white line down the center of roadways has saved countless lives.
- ♥ CFWC assisted with funding and installation of California's mission bells along the El Camino Real.
- ♥ CFWC proposed a state bill to establish California's Juvenile Court. Clubs paid the salaries of probation officers until funds could be budgeted by the State.
- ♥ CFWC clubs have donated books and educational material worth more than \$1.3 million to public and school libraries.
- ♥ CFWC helped create window stickers for use by fire depts. to identify disabled persons living in homes...and, the list goes on!
